I. Company Profile

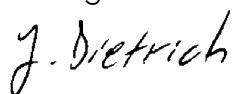
Febrotec GmbH is a leading distributor of technical springs and engineered components in Germany with an extensive product range, shipping to more than 70,000 customers worldwide.

We see it as our duty to ensure that all raw materials are used responsibly in the production and packaging of our springs. All our standard springs as well as their packaging comply with the legal environmental and health requirements and do not contain any materials that have been used to fund or support armed groups in conflict areas through mining and trade.

Febrotec GmbH uses recyclable packaging materials and relies almost exclusively on paper and cardboard for its packaging, as well as resealable LDPE press-seal bags. We confirm the participation of packaging according to a dual system in accordance with the provision of the German Packaging Act (VerpackG). All our packaging is licensed with the German Packaging Act (VerpackG) registered with the LUCID Packaging Register, a system participation with a dual system for recycling and data reporting and can therefore be recycled free of charge via the local collection of recyclable materials (paper bin, yellow bin/yellow bag, etc.).

We deliver our products exclusively to our terms and conditions and we expressly object to any additional or different terms and conditions of sale. As a matter of principle, we will neither sign nor accept any other documents, contracts or agreements.

Declaration

II. Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

We hereby confirm and warrant that all packaging materials supplied by us have been designed, manufactured, and placed on the market in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR).

We confirm that the packaging material supplied by us is manufactured in accordance with recyclability requirements ("Design for Recycling", cf. Article 6 of the PPWR), compliance with the requirements regarding recycled content (cf. Article 7 of the PPWR), compliance with applicable substance restricts (cf. Article 5 of the PPWR), the application of material-specific markings (cf. Article 11 of the PPWR), the technical conformity of the supplied packaging components.

TSCA / Heavy Metals / PFAS

We hereby confirm and warrant that the packaging we are currently supplying does not contain the following persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic chemicals: PIP (3:1) (phenol, isopropylated phosphate), DeCaBDE (decabromodiphenyl ether), HCBd (hexachlorobutadiene), PCTP (pentachlorothiophenol) and TTBP (2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol).

We hereby confirm and warrant that the total concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium in the packaging currently supplied by Febrotec GmbH does not exceed the heavy metal limit of 100 mg/kg (Article 5(4)).

The packaging we supply contains the spring steel grades we sell (1.4310 /V21, 1.1200/1.1211, 1.1274) and CuBe2 (1.124/), and does not come into contact with food.

The corrugated cardboard packaging and transparent LDPE press-seal bags we supply do not contain any intentionally added PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) and complies with the PFAS limit values (Article 5(5)): 25 ppb for an individual PFAS, 250 ppb for the total PFAS content and 50 ppm for total PFAS, including polymeric PFAS.

POP Regulation 2019/1021

The requirements of Regulation 2019/1021 on persistent organic pollutants are met by the corrugated board packaging we supply.

POP substances are not used in the manufacturing of corrugated board packaging.

REACH-Regulation 1907/2006/EG

Under REACH (EC No. 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL OF 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) – Communication on Substances of Very High Concern, the EU chemicals regulation, Article 33 requires suppliers of articles to inform recipients if a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) is present above 0.1% weight by weight. SVHCs are listed on the Candidate List published and regularly updated by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

We hereby confirm and warrant that the corrugated cardboard packaging and transparent LDPE press-seal bags supplied by Febrotec GmbH do not contain any articles in which substances from the current REACH Candidate List (SVHC List) from 2.2026 containing 253 substances are present in a concentration exceeding 0.1% by weight.

Wax / Paraffin

We hereby confirm and warrant that no wax or paraffin has been used in the manufacturing of our corrugated cardboard packaging.

Bisphenol-A

We hereby confirm and warrant that bisphenol-A was not used either in the production of corrugated paper or in the manufacturing of corrugated cardboard. To date, no phenols have been detected in corrugated board.

MOSH / MOAH

We hereby confirm and warrant that we do not use MOSH (mineral oil saturated hydrocarbons) or MOAH (mineral oil aromatic hydrocarbons) in printing inks for packaging. The prescribed environmental labels are affixed to packaging.

Conflict Minerals

We hereby confirm and warrant that none of the conflict minerals – tin, gold, tantalum, tungsten, cobalt and mica – have been used in the manufacturing of our corrugated cardboard packaging and transparent LDPE press-seal bags.

We hereby confirm and warrant that the paper grades used in our cardboard packaging, and transparent LDPE press-seal bags comply with the provisions of Regulation (EU) No. 1935/2004 and Regulation (EU) No 2023/2006 and are suitable for use as transport or secondary packaging for foodstuffs.

Adhesive

We hereby confirm and warrant that the corrugated board adhesive used in manufacturing our packaging and corrugated cardboard packaging complies with the requirements of Regulations (EC) No. 1935/2004 and No. 2023/2006.
